6. What are the seating arrangements?

These are done at the discretion of DCCC and any parties less than 8 may be on a shared table. Parties larger than 12 will be asked to allocate their guests a table using the online booking system Creventa or email events@derbyshireccc.com with your required seating plan before 21st November 2025. We will provide place cards for each of your guests, and these will be on the table ready for your arrival.

7. When are final balances due?
