FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is the Dress Code?

4. Do you accept cash?

No, we DO NOT accept cash as we are a cashless venue.

6. What are the seating arrangements?

These are at the discretion of DCCC and any parties less than 10 guests are not guaranteed their own table, any parties over 10 we will make every effort to place you next to one another. We will provide place cards for each of your guests with their menu choices detailed. These will be in the centre of the table for you to allocate accordingly unless we receive a table plan in advance. We will inform you ahead of your party what you table allocations are for you table plans.

7. When are final balances due?

Final balances are due by 13th November 2026, failure for balances to be made after this date will result in cancellation of your party booking and all monies paid will be lost. Please note only one payment per party, individual payments are not accepted due to the volume of guests. Please also note all deposits are none refundable or transferable.
